Project / Organisation	Donation	Description
North Cornwall and District Talking Newspaper	£504	To replace and upgrade the equipment for recording a weekly newspaper for blind and partially sighted local residents of North Cornwall.
Cornwall Young Farmers	£250	For a Competition Day in Wadebridge to offer young people the chance to develop their skills in stock judging, cookery, fencing, design (art and crafts), machinery handling and sports.
Egloshayle Pre-school	£491	To purchase a new computer for the present and future children of Egloshayle Pre-School to use, to replace their very old computer, mouse and software.
Loaves and fishes Community Help Café	£1000	To set up a Community Help Café to offer a helping hand to those in need by offering a wholesome meal and to offer whatever support is needed.
St Breock Primary School	£500	To build an outdoor learning shelter and fire pit in the wooded area of the school grounds to provide children with exploration and nature-based learning opportunities.
Wadebridge Carnival	£1000	Towards this year's Wadebridge Town Carnival.
Wadebridge Toy Library	£327.84	To buy new toys to overhaul their stock, which was last updated about 2 years ago.
Wadebridge Youth Project Community Video and Mural	£750	Towards the production of a youth community video and mural to give young people in the area the chance to interact with the community as well as learn new skills.
Moor Harmony	£411	To hold free one and half hour singing course every Thursday for 6 weeks from September to October for ladies of all ages and backgrounds from the Wadebridge area.
Wadebridge Creative Hub	£250	For an illuminated bicycle procession around the streets of Wadebridge and culminating in a celebratory event with performance, music and dancing, food and a bar on a large open outdoor area in town and a programme of open community workshops in September/October.

Wadebridge Girlguiding	£750	To purchase 2 table storage units which can be placed in the corners of the rooms to improve the safety aspect of the hall and reduce the need to paint over the damaged walls 3 or 4 times a year.
Growing Wild Cornwall	£500	To buy equipment to support its local Forest School activities, enabling them to provide a broader range of activities for children from the Wadebridge and St Breock areas.
Wednesday Arts and Craft Group (ARC)	£100	To buy silk and paints for new activities and to organise a visit to a gallery.
Wadebridge Bowls Club	£240	To purchase suitable equipment to encourage local youngsters in and around Wadebridge to take up bowls.
Whiterock Residents	£760	To replace the light fittings for the Coronation Park War Memorial to enable the memorial to be properly illuminated at night.
Wadebridge Memory Café Association	£1000	To buy audio visual equipment for use in the participation sessions for people living with memory loss, and their family and friends.
Treraven Farm	£365.16	To purchase a shed to store donated tools for use in nature gardening and woodland management activities.
May Play	£500	Towards the free, two day event in Wadebridge which brings together children and young people aged 0 - 18 years from communities across North Cornwall in a celebration of art, dance, storytelling, circus skills, music, physical activity and environmental activities all under the theme of 'play'.
Time to Shine Club	£200	To purchase instruments which children can borrow and learn to play at the Time to Shine musical club.
